In 1811, Sylvestre Forest Morstein joined the Regiment de Meuron's and was sent to Canada to serve. The Regiment was disbanded in July of 1816. At this time, Sylvestre chose to remain and settle in Canada.

Catarina Barbara Flaxman fled Germany on March 17<sup>th</sup>, 1817. She settled in Canada where she met and married Sylvestre on October 17<sup>th</sup>, 1820. Their son, Jacob Godfrey was born May 4<sup>th</sup>, 1824. The new family was once torn apart

Sylvestre married **Catarina (Catharine) B. Flax(Chs)Man [2]** [MRIN: 1], daughter of **John Lawless [1564]** and **Maria Margaret (Flachman) Flaxman [1563]**, on Oct 17, 1820 in Wickham, Que. Catarina was born in 1804 in Germany, died on Dec 13, 1880 in Durham Anglican, Qc aged 76, and was buried in St. Paul's, L'avenir, Qc. They had one son: **Jacob Godfrey**.

#### A STORY FROM LUCY MACKINNON- JOSEPH & AMELIA'S GRANDDAUGHTER



When I was almost eight years old, in September 1918, my mother, Myrtle, had influenza. That year influenza had been a deadly disease for thousands of victims. The camphor squares we wore in cotton bags around our necks had not spared my mother. My grandmother (Amelia Wright Mastine) had come to our farm home to take care of my mother, my brother Lawrence (four), myself and the household of hired men and my father. When the phone rang 1 & 5 (one long and five short rings) my grandmother listened to her own number on our seventeen-party line system. A man's voice asked for my grandfather and he was brought in from the barn or the field. The voice read the telegram that said my Uncle Stanley had been "killed in action". My grandmother turned from the

At the back of the first floor was the real "workshop". Here were fashioned axe handles, as well as handles for other implements, and for a variety of handmade tools shaped and molded in the forge. **They are but one example of the talents, imagination and creativeness of Mastines.** A "jibbon horse", designed and built by Dad, afforded a vice and seat for the craftsman while he used a shave to shape the ax handles. This provided Marge and me with wooden ringlets that we could tuck under the edge of our Hat. At that time all little girls longed for curly hair. Permanents were not common in the 20's, so for Marge and me, wooden ones sufficed.

Upstairs lumber was stored. Here Elwyn spent hours building a large cage to house a raccoon he'd caught in a trap and which he would have as a pet. His dream was brief lasting one night. Chicken wire and 2 x 4's pose no deterrent to a coon's teeth.

On the opposite side of the road, we see the "old house" shaded by huge elm that survived until recent times. the old house provided an

**3 tbsp. butter**

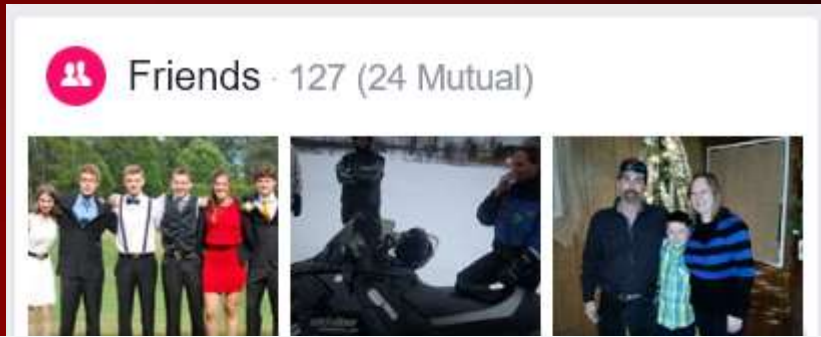
Grind the tea/flowers using a pestle and mortar or a makeshift one.

- Let the mixture cool for a few minutes then add in the marshmallows.
- Drop by spoonfuls on a cookie sheet covered in waxed paper.
